



Letter of Invitation: Inviting Family Members and Friends to Canada

You might be planning to invite family members and/or friends to come visit you in Canada, perhaps for significant moments in your academic career such as graduation ceremonies. When your family and/or friends are submitting applications for visas to Canada, they may be asked for a letter of invitation from the person they are going to visit in Canada. This is called a [Letter of Invitation](#) and should be completed by you, the student.

NBCC does not provide any documents for visa applications for family members of students. Instead, to include in their application for a visitor visa. This letter comes directly from you and NBCC does not need to sign or stamp this letter.
